**HONORING THE 2022 CHAMPION FORT BRAGG HIGH SCHOOL
GIRLS SOFTBALL TEAM**

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg High School girls softball team went undefeated this year and were declared the 2022 champions of the North Central League I; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg girls softball team had a sterling record of 13 wins and no losses in the League; and

WHEREAS, the team made it to the North Coast Sectional playoffs where they took Second Place, the furthest a Fort Bragg softball team has ever gone; and

WHEREAS, this is the first League Championship for the Fort Bragg girls softball team since 2011, a particularly impressive feat since the league has been expanded to include dominant schools such as Clearlake, Saint Helena and Cloverdale; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg girls softball team only allowed 18 runs in League in 13 games; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg City Council wishes to recognize this championship team, its coaches, and its supporters, for a truly outstanding season;
