**RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL
ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT
FOR THE BOLLARD AND STREET LIGHT PROJECT, CITY PROJECT PWP-
00127, TO FORT BRAGG ELECTRIC, INC., APPROVING BUDGET
AMENDMENT NO. 2022/23-11, ADJUSTING THE FY 2022/23 BUDGET TO
APPROPRIATE \$299,276.54 FROM THE 2022 STREETS PROJECT
(ACCOUNT NO. 250-7999-0799 TO 421-7999-7999), AUTHORIZING CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$299,276.54; ACCOUNT NO. 421-4870-0731) AND FINDING THE PROJECT
EXEMPT FROM CEQA**

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Public Contract Code 20164 and other applicable laws, the Bollard and Street Light Project, City Project No. PWP-00127 (the "Project") was advertised for bid on November 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received for this Project from the following contractors: M3 Integrated Services, Inc., Fort Bragg Electric, Inc., and F. Loduca Co.; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bragg Electric, Inc., is the apparent low bidder and the City has confirmed that Fort Bragg Electric, Inc., has the proper license, experience and meets the necessary requirements to complete the Project as bid; and

WHEREAS, with Budget Amendment 2022/23-11, funding in the amount of \$299,276.54 for the Project will be moved from the 2022 Streets Rehab Project, where the scope of work for this project was originally approved; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available for this contract from the 2022 Streets Rehab project which was budgeted in the FY 2022/23 and included this activity; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

1. The bid of Fort Bragg Electric, Inc. is the lowest bid, meets the requirements of the Project bid documents, and is considered responsive.
2. Fort Bragg Electric, Inc. and its subcontractors have the proper licenses to complete the Project and based upon previous experience in completing similar projects, is a responsible bidder.
3. The adjustments to the FY 2022-23 Budget have been identified and are necessary, as shown in Exhibit A.
4. Sufficient funds are available to fully build the Project with the Budget Amendment 2022/23-11.
5. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are made a part of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby accept the design of the project (Exhibit B); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Project is exempt by CEQA section 15301 (C) which allows for repair, maintenance, and/or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities and further exempt by Public Resources Code–PRC 21080(b)(1) as a Ministerial project proposed to be carried out by a Public Agency; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby accept the bid of Fort Bragg Electric, Inc. as the lowest responsive bidder for the Bollard and Street Light Project, City Project No. PWP-00127, approves Budget Amendment 2022/23-11, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract upon execution by Contractor (Amount Not to Exceed \$299,276.54; Account No. 421-4870-0731).
