original labels and be empty, clean, and dry. Please do not crush cans. A valid California ID is required Customers are limited to 100 pounds of aluminum maximum, 100 pounds of plastic maximum, and 1,000 pounds of glass maximum. Customers exceeding the daily limit will be turned away

Eligible CRV container items include:

- Beer and malt beverages
- · Wine coolers and distilled spirit coolers
- Carbonated fruit drinks, water or soft drinks
- Non-carbonated fruit drinks, water or soft drinks
- Coffee and tea beverages
- 100% fruit juice less than 46 oz.
- Vegetable juice 16 oz. or less
- Sports drinks

Starting January 1, 2024, Distilled Spirits and Wine (including sparkling and alcohol removed wine) in any container material, including box, bladder, or pouch, will also be eligible


