The draft letter currently includes "Our organization brings to the table the collective knowledge and experience of our staff in the areas of community development and outreach, economic growth and development, financial management, and grants management." Our current staff is under-qualified and woefully ineffective concerning "community development and outreach, economic growth and development" although financial and grants management appear to be solid.
