RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE COMPENSATION PLAN CONFIRMING PAY RATES/RANGES FOR CITY OF FORT BRAGG POLICE ASSOCIATION CLASSIFICATIONS

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg City Council approves all salary schedules which include classification titles and compensation rates; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this Resolution meets the requirements of California Regulations Section 570.5 as confirmed by the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Bragg City Council approved Resolution 4426-2021 on August 9, 2021 approving 2021-2022 Memorandum of Understanding with the Fort Bragg Police Association authorizing a three percent (3%) cost of living adjustment effective July 3, 2022 for Fort Bragg Police Association classifications; and

WHEREAS, CalPERS code requires the City to have a publicly adopted and posted salary schedule; and

WHEREAS, the compensation schedule is required to be updated to reflect the previously approved cost of living increase for Fort Bragg Police Association employees; and

WHEREAS, the full salary schedule is allocated in the Proposed FY 2022/2023 budget; and

WHEREAS, the full salary schedule is available on the City's website.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby establish a compensation plan, terms, and conditions of employment for all established classifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby adopt the City of Fort Bragg Salary Rate Compensation Plan for Fort Bragg Police Association classifications as presented in "Exhibit A", effective retroactive to July 3, 2022.
