## A RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE OFFICE OF THIS CITY THAT WAS TO BE ELECTED ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, as of the close of the nomination period on Friday, August 7, 2020, there are not more candidates than offices to be elected and that § 10229 of the Elections Code allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council:

- 1. Appoint to the office the person or persons who have been nominated.
- 2. Appoint to the office any eligible voter if no one has been nominated.
- 3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

**WHEREAS**, a Notice of these facts was posted in three public locations in the city pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

Section 1: That pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the following action is being taken:

**BERNIE NORVELL** is being appointed to the office to which he was nominated and is considered to be the same as being elected, pursuant to § 10229(a)(3) of the Elections Code.

<u>Section 2</u>: The election scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, is now canceled.

<u>Section 3:</u> The person appointed shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office.

<u>Section 4</u>: The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
