Dear Ms. Jones:

As the Engineer of Record for the project, I am submitting this Letter of Completion for your records. On January 5, 2018 I inspected the completed project with you, Tom Varga and Jeff Green of Akeff Construction. At that time, we found the project to be substantially complete and in accordance with the project plans and specifications with the exception of the bathroom and plaza and several minor punch list items. These remaining items have since been completed, visually inspected by our inspector and the City independently, and found to be complete.

During the course of construction, SHN had an inspector at the project site, acting on the behalf of the City, to insure all grading, drainage, and site development activities were completed in accordance with the plans. Also, as the Engineer of Record, I regularly visited the site and met with the contractor to confirm that the project was constructed to the specifications on the plans. I have submitted our daily inspection logs for your records. Our inspector performed compaction tests and materials testing on the base rock and concrete used throughout the project. A binder with all of our materials testing results has been delivered to the City.

As part of our roles as Project Inspector and Resident Engineer we have performed the required documentation in accordance with labor compliance procedures, including contractor workforce Employee Interviews. These records have also been submitted to the City for your use.

As the QSP SWPPP inspector, we have also submitted our SWPPP inspections for your records and project close-out. Should you need additional assistance during SWPPP CGP close out I am available to provide any support required.
