BACKGROUND AND OVERVIEW:

The City solicited quotes from qualified manufacturers, artists, and woodworkers to replace the Harold O. Bainbridge Park Welcome Sign. The existing sign is outdated and requires an upgrade as part of the overall Bainbridge Park Enhancement Project. The Request for Proposals (RFP) established criteria for a design that was both creative and artistic and captures the playful nature of a park for signage. Additionally, the RFP required:

- ❖ Sign Text should include the:
 - “Harold O. Bainbridge Park”
 - City of Fort Bragg name or logo (high-quality graphic available).
 - Park Hours: Dawn to Dusk with Spanish translation “Horario del parque: del amanecer al anochecer”

- ❖ Any additional proposed text will require Spanish translation.
- ❖ Proposed Welcome Sign material may consist of Redwood Heart B, High-Density-Urethane (HDU), or other high-quality material that is coastal weather resistant.
- ❖ If the Welcome Sign is to be painted, the use of marine-grade paint is required.
- ❖ The new Welcome Sign shall be no larger than the existing sign configuration, i.e. no more than 6' high, 8' wide, and a maximum thickness of 9".
- ❖ Both Post-mount and Monument style signs will be considered.

SCOPE OF WORK

Specific work tasks shall include:

1. Design a new sign, and receive final approval on the sign schematic.
2. Manufacture a new Welcome Sign.
3. Deliver the sign to the City of Fort Bragg if not proposing installation.
4. The proposer may also choose to install the sign, or this activity may be undertaken by City Public Works Staff. If the proposer installs the sign, they should bid that portion of the work as an alternate item. Persons electing to install signage must comply with prevailing wages, maintain necessary contractors' licensure, and provide sufficient insurance coverage endorsements.

The **proposal** content requested the inclusion of:

1. Sign design in color.
2. Sign dimensions.
3. Total cost of sign including post(s) or monument fixture.
4. Alternate cost for installation of the sign (if proposing). Please include as a separate line item, the cost to install the sign, including all posts, brackets, and hardware. All hardware must be 304 stainless steel. Proper licensure is required to bid on this alternate. (optional)
5. Project schedule – The Bainbridge Park Enhancement project is set to commence in early spring 2025. The sign shall be completed no later than March 1, 2025, unless an alternate agreement is reached with the selected sign contractor.

Proposal submittals were due November 15, 2024. The City received six (6) proposals which are summarized in a matrix form and depicted in the attachments. The Bainbridge Park Enhancement Project is funded by the State Parks Program grant for which the city received \$2,063,100. The replacement sign is one element of the overall project with a current projected unit cost (including installation) of \$16,800.00. Several of the signs submitted fall within this budget range and many others far exceed the available funding.

RECOMMENDATION:

Review the six (6) signs and make a recommendation for selection. If a more expensive sign is selected, funding options need to be explored to cover excess costs.

Dear Councilmembers Peters and Albin-Smith~

Good morning. I hope that this afternoon you will select a sign or signs to bring forward to the City Council that is/are in keeping with the architecture of the park and proposed pavilion as those are features that will be long-lived and continuity with them improves the overall look of the park. I have some comments about the park signage:

It's unfortunate that the current sign is a mish-mash, with the metal sign added to the top of the original, but the signs on the tennis court fence are in much worse shape than the sign at the corner. It seems like they should be a higher priority. And the park hours should be posted at all of the park entrances with signage matching the main sign. The sign to be replaced isn't located at a park entrance. Perhaps a simpler design could be obtained and all signage could be replaced and look good, rather than a lone nice sign in the corner while the others are in such a sad state.

A maintenance issue to consider is that it would be more difficult to access the grass and weeds between a monument style base and the fence than mowing between the posts from the front. And, as trimming doesn't happen on a regular basis in the park, a post style sign will not look as unkempt as a monument style when the grass grows tall around it.

You might want to re-consider requiring a double-faced sign since it will be located along the outer fence at the corner of the park. The "back" side of the sign will not be easily seen or read. You could opt to have a mural painted by a local artist on the back instead.

Why isn't the current bronze plaque included in the design for historic purpose? If it is not included, what is the plan for it?

Although they propose to use redwood, not just generic "wood" stained to match redwood as others propose, I would be a bit wary considering a company whose proposal includes "DUST TO DAWN" instead of "DAWN TO DUSK" as the park hours on both sign options. It might be an indication of lack of attention to detail.
