NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Fort Bragg City Council will conduct a public hearing at a regular meeting to be held at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on **MONDAY, MARCH 10, 2014**, at the Town Hall, southwest corner of Main and Laurel Streets (363 North Main Street), Fort Bragg, California 95437, to discuss the submittal of an application in response to the 2013 State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and to solicit citizen input.

The City of Fort Bragg is applying for a grant in an amount of up to \$846,151 under the NOFA for the following eligible activity:

- 1) An Over-the-Counter application from the Economic Development Allocation to provide a loan to Sportz Investment Inc. DBA Sport Chrysler Jeep Dodge (up to \$796,151 including allowable Activity Delivery funds of up to \$40,000);
- 2) Grant Administration funds as allowed (up to \$50,000).

None of the above activities are expected to result in displacement of residents or business owners. Grant activities will be conducted within the City of Fort Bragg.


The purpose of the public hearing is to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known on the proposed activities and application.
