3. CONDUCT OF BUSINESS

A. 24-760 Review Design Options for Park Pavilion and Make Recommendation to City Council to Authorize Consultant to Proceed with Construction Documents for

Bainbridge Park Enhancement Project

Assistant Director Chantell O'Neal gave a brief overview of the project and introduced Patrick from Melton Design Group who is the design consultant for the project.

Patrick discussed the significance of the Bainbridge Park Master Plan and its relevance to today's conversation. He then presented four potential pavilion locations, with two size options, highlighting the advantages and disadvantages of each site. Additionally, he provided a sun path analysis for each location. Patrick also explained how the pavilions would fit into the overall park design, including their integration with adding additional picnic tables.

Discussion: Committee Member Peters expressed his approval of the middle location pavilion option one in the larger size and elaborated on why he believes that would be the best location

and size.

Committee Member Albin-Smith explained while she does favor the location of option four she would prefer to see an option that is round instead of square and is more centrally located in the lawn area. She also expressed she is not in favor of the tiled look to match the Veterans building and would prefer to see something with redwood.

Committee Member Peters summarized that while the committee members may not agree on location and design they both agree that we need a pavilion in Bainbridge Park and recommended taking the discussion back to City Council.

City Manager Isaac Whippy inquired about the height of the stage and what is located behind. Patrick explained the options for backdrops and height.

Public Comment was received from Jacob Patterson and Jenny.

Assistant Director Chantell O'Neal summarized direction received from Committee Members and proposed options to bring to City Council.

Dear Ms. O'Neal,

On February 16, 2024, Lumos and Associates performed a site visit to evaluate the existing conditions of roadways identified for Maintenance and Rehabilitation (M&R) by City of Ft. Bragg. The project selection and proposed M&R strategies were identified utilizing the City's StreetSaver® pavement management database. Forty-six (46) pavement management sections were identified as candidates for inclusion in the City's 2025 Pavement Preservation and Rehabilitation Project. Table 1 includes the proposed pavement management sections, StreetSaver® M&R recommendation, and Lumos's visual observation and M&R recommendation.

Areas identified for "Surface Treatment" are proposed to receive either a Slurry Seal or Microsurfacing treatment. Pavement condition and existing curb ramp compliance will receive a complete review during our upcoming field assessment. Upon the conclusion of our assessment, Lumos will provide specific surface treatment and pedestrian access ramp improvement recommendations.

Based upon the proposed treatments identified during our initial site visit, it is our recommendation that the 2025 Pavement Preservation Project be limited to surface treatments (slurry seal and/or microsurfacing) only. The small quantities of work identified for Corrective Maintenance and Rehabilitation would likely result in bid pricing far in excess of those typical for the area due to the lack of production quantities and discontinuity of the proposed work. The four streets identified in italic text are recommended for reconstruction in StreetSaver®, however our observations of these streets suggests they are good candidates for surface treatment. The proposed surface treatment candidate are included in Table 2.

The 2011 Alley Master Plan recommends improvements to several of the alleys that are subject to improvements with this project. The table below shows the subject alleys and the recommended improvements from the 2011 Alley Master Plan. The costs above do not include grading and drainage improvements to the Alleys. During the Kickoff Meeting on 4/30/24 it was decided that only surface treatment would be considered for the alleys, if budget allows.

During our Kickoff Meeting, Operations and Maintenance staff identified concerns with drainage on Laurel Street, specifically the bubblers at N. Whipple St and N. Corry St. Research was performed into the 2004 Storm Drainage Master Plan (Pages 44 – 47). Discussion on page 44 identified the cross drain at the intersection of Laurel St. and Whipple St. as not functioning properly. The study also stated that in January and February of 2004 City engineering staff was working on a design to improve the drainage at this location, and therefore the Master Plan did not include recommendations for resolution. If the City would like to improve drainage at the bubblers along Laurel St. with this project, we will need to collect additional topographic information to facilitate design of a solution.

Based upon our initial recommendations and our 4/30 discussion, we have included the updated preliminary cost estimate below:
