Help Shape the Future of the C.V. Starr Community Center

The City of Fort Bragg is considering applying for up to \$10 million from the California Strategic Growth Council's Community Resilience Centers Program to advance Phase III of the C.V. Starr Community Center.

The proposed expansion could serve as a year-round recreation and community facility while also functioning as a Community Resilience Center during power outages, wildfires, extreme heat, poor air quality, severe storms, earthquakes, and other emergencies.

Potential improvements include a multipurpose basketball gym and emergency shelter, retractable stage, commercial kitchen, clean-air respite area, emergency supplies, backup power, broadband, medical support, expanded fitness space, and community training rooms.

No final design has been approved. Your feedback will help determine the project's priorities, design, services, and grant application.
