**RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMING THE PAY RATES AND RANGES FOR ALL CITY OF FORT BRAGG ESTABLISHED CLASSIFICATIONS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026**

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Bragg City Council approves all new classifications and salary schedules, which include classification titles and compensation rates as reflected in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of this Resolution meets the requirements of California Code of Regulations Section 570.5 as confirmed by CalPERS; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Bragg City Council approved Resolution 4953-2025 that established a 5% cost-of-living adjustment for the Executive Management employee group; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Bragg City Council approved Resolution 4939-2025 that established a 5% cost-of-living adjustment for the Mid-Manager employee group; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Public Employees' Retirement System requires the City to have a publicly adopted and posted salary schedule, and it is best practice to have all the recent changes effective on July 1, 2025, on one master salary schedule; and

**WHEREAS**, the full salary schedule is allocated in the FY 2026/27 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the full salary schedule is available on the City's website; and

**WHEREAS**, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows.

1. Adopt the City of Fort Bragg Master Salary Rate Compensation Plan as presented in "Exhibit A".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Fort Bragg does hereby amend the City of Fort Bragg Master Salary Rate Compensation Plan as presented in "Exhibit A" effective July 1, 2026.
