

## RESOLUTION NO. 4858-2024

### RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMING SUPPORT OF THE COHORT-4 PROPOSITION 47 GRANT

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Bragg desires to participate in the Proposition 47 Grant administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as BSCC).; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 47 Grant is a grant program to public agencies aimed at supporting mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, and diversion programs for people in the criminal justice system, with an emphasis on programs that reduce recidivism of people convicted of less serious crimes, such as those covered by this measure, and those who have substance abuse and mental health problems. (Gov. Code, § 7599.2, subd. (a)(3).); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Manager be authorized on behalf of the City of Fort Bragg City Council to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
