Thank you for the opportunity to provide you with this quote and summary of intentions regarding design and construction of the Council Dais and lectern for Fort Bragg Town Hall. We are looking forward to working with all of you as we go through the process of creating these new pieces for our city.

Qualifications and Experience constructing similar types of furniture

Wood Joint Studio is comprised of Bob Sanderson and Taimi Barty. We both came to Fort Bragg in the late 1990s specifically to attend the College of the Redwoods Fine Woodworking Program, studying under James Krenov. Since our two years in the program, we have both been working as full time cabinet makers, creating furniture, cabinetry, doors and windows for both private homes as well as businesses in the area. Our experience of working with local businesses to create the woodwork needed specifically for each business is the main reason that we feel we are very qualified for this job. In order for woodwork to be durable and long lasting in a public setting it is essential that the design of the piece is strong, easy to operate and easy to maintain. We hope that our intended design has taken these key requirements into consideration.

Over the past 10 years Bob and I have had the great opportunity to work with many local businesses and organizations. We have included contact information for some of the business owners. Please feel free to contact them should you wish.

Racines Office and Art Supplies: We designed and constructed the cash register counter in maple and redwood, the paper display racks along the south wall, a maple and glass display case as well as storage cabinets for oversized paper. Susan Juntz's contact number is (707) 964-2416.

Gallery Bookshop and Bookwinkle's Childrens Books: We designed and constructed the circular cash register island, the window seats along the west wall of the building as well as some

Saucy Restaurant in Ukiah: We worked with the owner and architects to design and then construct a bar in steel and recycled redwood, bifold windows that open out onto Stanley Street allowing for additional seating as well as a 10 foot long redwood and steel slab table and a pizza pole by the wood fired oven. Highlight Gallery: In addition to selling our work at the gallery, we were commissioned to design and build a display case in old growth redwood and glass. Sharon's contact number is (707) 937-3132.

City of Fort Bragg: We have constructed a 51" circular frame in redwood, salvaged from the mill site that will hang behind the Council Dais in Town Hall. We have also designed and constructed a bench, chair and table in redwood and stainless steel to be placed out on the Coastal Trail later this month.

**Performance Specifications** 

Wood Joint Studio will comply with all requirements as set forth in the RFQ for Town Hall Dais and Lectern under the heading of Performance Specifications.

The "uniqueness of Fort Bragg and Mendocino" means many different things to different people at different times. Two over aching characteristics, however, are simplicity and beauty. It is for this reason that we have chosen to stay with Schlosser and Newberger's basic design of the Council Dais. The simple curve, featuring the horizontal grain and the solid cherry tops speak to those key characteristics. We intend to use plain sliced, sequence matched cherry plywood for the curved fronts, to create the harmonious and continuous feel, from the audience's perspective. The solid tops will be 1" thick. The lectern will also have a curved front and solid cherry top to match the Council Dais. We concur that Cherry is a good wood to use for this application. It is very stable, ages well and is quite durable. There are certainly options to use more local woods, however, this would drive the price up significantly and so, we suggest staying with Cherry. Please see attachment A for sketches of the Council Dais and lectern.

Each individual unit of the Council Dais will be constructed on a steel frame. We intend to use steel as it will provide the necessary strength without compromising the usable space under the cabinet. The sides of the cabinet will be attached to the steel frame, transferring the load onto the casters. The casters will be attached to this frame and will not be visible. The choice of casters is very important as these will dictate the ease with which the units are moved. The more compliant the motion to the user, the less damage will occur over time. It is for this reason that we have chosen a 3" swivel caster, high capacity gray rubber tire on polyolefin center with anular ball bearings, rated at 200 lb. each. Please see attachment B for details on the casters we intend to use. Two of the four castors will be lockable.

Again, focusing on ease for the end user, as well as the simple and beautiful, we intend to construct the wire chases in plywood so that there is plenty of room and easy access, when necessary. The four openings for the wire interconnections in the ends of the units will be quite visible and we have chosen an elegant, square grommet in Aluminum, with a brushed finish. This will match well with the cherry and be an elegant detail in the sides of the cases. The additional feature that we really like with this

grommet is that it has a hinged gate for easy access when adding or adjusting cords. Please see attachment C for details on the hinged grommets.

Quality of Workmanship

Wood Joint Studio strives for the highest quality of craftsmanship, always. Requisite in such high quality is a design that will stand the test of time and that will interact well with the users. Those who come in contact with our work should feel comfortable and happy, which ultimately leads to less wear and tear on the piece. This is our mission.







## Attachment C: METAL CABLE GROMMET

#### Metal Cable Gromm



Press-fit or glued in place, these capped metal grommets give a tidy, finished appearance to holes used to let cords and cables through office furniture, computer desks or wall units. Nylon bristles lining the portal keep light tension on cords, helping to keep them in position while permitting adjustment.

Made of zamak with a stainless-steel finish, the round grommets install in material at least 1/2" thick and have a removable cap for cord access.

Aluminum with a brushed finish, the square and rectangular grommets are suitable for 7/8" material or thicker, and have a hinged gate for easier access when adding or adjusting cords.

Sizes refer to hole dimensions.



## Attachment D: KEYBOARD TRAY HARDNARE

#### 50 lb Linder-Wount Slides



For use wherever you need a retractable shelf or tray, these slides are primarily designed for computer keyboards.
