E-Bicycle/Motorcycle guide



9.68.020 DEFINITIONS

- A. Motorized vehicles of any kind or nature shall be prohibited from accessing any portion of a park (other than parking lots and/or access roads), except for the following: emergency vehicles; vehicles of the City and its duly authorized representatives or agents; strollers and similar children's carriages; wheelchairs; and vehicles whose owners have first obtained a permit from the Director of Public Works for temporary access for activities as may be approved by the City.

9.68.020 DEFINITIONS

- K. Motorized bicycles and scooters are prohibited in all City parks.
- O. Rollerblades are permitted only on the bicycle and pedestrian trail at Pomo Bluffs Park and Noyo Headlands Park.



Class 1 / Class 2

- Equipped with an electric motor
- and pedal assisted (Class 1)
- and/or throttle assisted (Class 2),
- reaches the speed of 20 miles
- per hour.
- CVC 312.5(a)(1)/(2)

- - Under 18 must wear a helmet
- - Obey all rules of the road (i.e.
- Stop signs, signal lights, lane
- markings)

- Equipment:

- - Lights/reflectors during
- Darkness

- Restrictions:

Class 3



Class 3

Equipped with a motor that

provides assistance only when

the rider is pedaling, and that

ceases to provide assistance

when the bicycle reaches the

speed of 28 miles per hour and

equipped with a speedometer.

Moped/Motorized Bicycle



Two-wheeled or three-wheeled device having fully operative pedals for propulsion by human power or having no pedals if powered solely by electrical energy, and an automatic transmission and a motor that produces less than 4 gross brake horsepower and can propel the device at a maximum speed of not more than 30 miles per hour.

CVC 406(a)

Requirements

- Must have M1/M2 endorsement
- on a driver's license
- - DOT helmet required for driver/passenger

- Equipment:
 - - Registered with DMV, headlight, tail light,
 - brake light, reflectors
 - - Brakes on both wheels
 - - One rearview mirror required
 - - Horn
 - - Insurance

- Restrictions:
 - - May not be operated on trails
 - *Vehicle may be Towed or Impounded

Motorized Scooter

Two-wheeled device that has handlebars, has either a floorboard that is designed to be stood upon when riding or a seat and footrests in place of the floorboard, and is powered by an electric motor. This device may also be designed to be powered by human propulsion.
CVC 407.5(a)



Requirements

- - Must ride in a bicycle lane
- - Under 18 must wear a helmet
- - Must have a valid driver's License

- Equipment:
 - - Head light, red rear reflector, side white/ yellow reflector
 - - Adequate muffler for exhaust/noise

- Restrictions:
 - - May not ride on a roadway posted higher than 25 mph, unless in a bicycle lane
 - - May not ride on the sidewalk
 - - May not exceed 15 mph
 - - May not modify exhaust

Motorcycle



Motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider, designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground.

A motor vehicle that has four wheels in contact with the ground, two of which are a functional part of a sidecar, is a motorcycle if the vehicle otherwise comes within the definition of subdivision (a).
CVC 400 (a)/(b)

- Requirements:
 - - Must have M1/M2 endorsement on a driver's license
 - - DOT helmet required for driver/passenger
- Equipment:
 - - Registered with DMV, headlight, tail light, brake light, reflectors
 - - Brakes on both wheels
 - - One rearview mirror required
 - - Horn
 - - Insurance
- Restrictions:
 - - May not be operated on trails
- *Vehicle may be Towed or Impounded

Motor Driven Cycle



Any motorcycle with a motor that displaces less than 150 cubic centimeters.

CVC 405

- Requirements:
 - - Must have M1 endorsement on a driver's license
 - - DOT helmet required for driver/passenger
- Equipment:
 - - Registered with DMV, headlight, tail light, brake light, reflectors
 - - Brakes on both wheels
 - - One rearview mirror required
 - - Horn
 - - Insurance
- Restrictions:
 - - May not be operated on trails
 - *Vehicle may be Towed or Impounded

Pocket Bikes



Two-wheeled motorized device that has a seat or saddle for the use of the rider, and that is not designed or manufactured for highway use.

"Pocket bike" does not include an off-highway motorcycle, as defined in Section 436.

CVC 473(a)

- Restrictions:
- - May not be operated on sidewalks, roadways, or trails
- *Vehicle may be Towed or Impounded for 48 hours
