NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Fort Bragg City Council will conduct a public hearing at a regular meeting to be held at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on **MONDAY, JUNE 8, 2015**, at the **Town Hall**, at the corner of Main and Laurel Streets (363 North Main Street), Fort Bragg, California. The City Council will solicit citizen input regarding the following:

Receive Report, Conduct Public Hearing, and Consider Adoption of City Council Resolution to Adopt Program Guidelines for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) HELP H2O Program.


The HELP H2O Program Guidelines are a comprehensive statement of the City's policies and procedures for implementation of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)-funded Home Energy Link Program - Water known as HELP H2O. This Program provides direct emergency financial assistance to low income persons for payment of delinquent City of Fort Bragg water bills. Program participants must be responsible for payment of a City water bill for their primary residence within the Program service area, which is within the city limits of the City of Fort Bragg. The Program Guidelines provide information about the program requirements and operation and ensure compliance with all CDBG federal and state eligibility and overlay requirements. The City has received funding for the HELP H2O Program from the 2014 CDBG allocation.

Information regarding the HELP H2O Program Guidelines, CDBG requirements, and the CDBG program are available during normal office hours at Fort Bragg City Hall, 416 North Franklin Street, Fort Bragg, CA 95437. Interested persons should appear at the above-noticed public hearing to make their comments known. If you are not able to attend the public hearing, please direct written comments to the City of Fort Bragg, Attention: Community Development Department, 416 North Franklin Street, Fort Bragg, CA 95437. If you plan to attend the public hearing and need a special accommodation because of a sensory or mobility impairment/disability or have a need for an interpreter, please contact City Hall at (707) 961-2823 to arrange for those accommodations to be made.


