Qualifications

All candidates must be:

- At least 18 years of age
- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Fort Bragg within city limits
- A registered voter
- Not convicted of designated crimes as specified in the Constitution and laws of the state



Important Dates

July 15, 2024

First day nomination papers will be issued.

August 9, 2024

Last day to file nomination papers if any incumbent files.

August 14, 2024

Last day to file nomination papers if any incumbent fails to file.



Document Filing

- There is no filing fee
- Nomination papers are issued by and filed with the City Clerk
- The City covers all expenses for candidate statements published in the voter pamphlet, in both English and Spanish.
- The Fair Political Practices Commission mandates campaign disclosure filings.
