Consider incentive to allow at public schools during school hours.	Yes, vendors would need to obtain written permission from restaurants within 200 feet of mobile vending locations	Mobile vending limited to 5 hours in any one location	No limits to the hours of operation have been identified	City could consider establishing vending zones where mobile vendors would cluster or allow for mobile vending throughout City limits except as noted. Concerns about mobile vending at or near Coastal Trail.	Yes, vendors would be required to comply with the Mendocino County Environmental Health regulations which require inspections as well as an inspection from the Fort Bragg Fire Department	Yes, mobile vendors would be required to operate from a commissary or commercial kitchen
