### **SEEKING APPLICANTS FOR INTERIM CITY APPOINTEE TO THE NOYO HARBOR DISTRICT COMMISSION**

Applications are being accepted from interested persons to fill one of the City of Fort Bragg's appointees to the Noyo Harbor District Commission on an interim basis, after the death last month of Noyo Harbor Commissioner Thomas Ancona. The term of the interim appointment will be from date of appointment until October 31, 2016.

The Fort Bragg City Council appoints two of the five members of the Commission, the County of Mendocino appoints two of the five members, and jointly with the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, the Council appoints the Chairman. Terms on the Commission are for a four year period.

Two positions (one City and one City/County) will be eligible for appointment in October 2016. The appointments will be for four-year terms which will run from November 14, 2016 to October 31, 2020.

To be eligible for appointment to the Commission you must reside within the boundaries of the Noyo Harbor District. Persons interested in appointment are urged to contact City Clerk June Lemos at 961-2823, ext. 115 to obtain an application form.

Applications are due Tuesday, June 21st by 5:00 p.m. and depending on the number of applications the City Council may wish to interview applicants at a special Council meeting, or at the June 27th City Council meeting.
