SEEKING APPLICANTS FOR INTERIM CITY APPOINTEE

TO THE NOYO HARBOR DISTRICT COMMISSION

Applications are being accepted from persons interested in serving as a City of Fort Bragg appointee to the Noyo Harbor District Commission on an interim basis, after the death last month of Noyo Harbor Commissioner Dusty Dillon. The term of the interim appointment will be from date of appointment until October 31, 2018. This position will be eligible for re-appointment in October 2018. The appointment will be for a four-year term which will run from October 31, 2018 to October 31, 2022.

The City of Fort Bragg appoints two of the five members of the Commission, the County of Mendocino appoints two of the five members, and the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors and Fort Bragg City Council jointly appoint the Chairman. Terms on the Commission are for a four-year period.

To be eligible for appointment to the Commission you must reside within the boundaries of the Noyo Harbor District. Persons interested in appointment are urged to contact City Clerk June Lemos at 961-1694 to confirm eligibility and to obtain an application form.

Applications are due Friday, January 12, 2018 by 5:00 p.m. Depending on the number of applications, the City Council may wish to interview applicants at a special Council meeting, or at the January 22, 2018 City Council meeting.
