If necessary, an additional 30 minutes shall be allotted to public comments after Conduct of Business, but only if the first 30-minute Public Comment period was not sufficient to allow all those who wished to speak to do so. Any citizen, after being recognized by the Mayor or acting Mayor, may speak on any topic that may be a proper subject for discussion before the City Council for such period of time as the Mayor or acting Mayor may determine is appropriate under the circumstances of the particular meeting, including but not limited to, the number of persons wishing to speak on a particular topic or at a particular meeting, or the complexity of a particular topic. Time limitations shall be set without regard to a speaker's point of view or the content of the speech, as

long as the speaker's comments are not disruptive of the meeting.

BROWN ACT REQUIREMENTS: Pursuant to the Brown Act, the Council cannot discuss issues or take action on any requests during this comment period.
