RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 APPROVING BUDGET AMENDMENT 2022/23-19 FOR THE PUDDING CREEK FORCE MAIN RELOCATION PROJECT AND AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000, ACCOUNT NO. 716-7005-0731)

WHEREAS, in 2008 the City and Municipal Improvement District located the Pudding Creek Sewer Force Main on the Pudding Creek Bridge; and

WHEREAS, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has plans to widen Pudding Creek Bridge in 2023; and

WHEREAS, the sewer line must be relocated in order for the bridge to be widened; and

WHEREAS, all costs except for construction of the utility pedestals must be paid by the Municipal Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans required that a Utility Relocation Agreement be executed to ensure that the cost of improvements will be covered before the Project can progress; and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2021, the Fort Bragg Municipal Improvement District No. 1 District Board approved the execution of that agreement in the amount of \$225,000; and

WHEREAS, in fall of 2022, Caltrans solicited bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2022, Caltrans opened the bids for the Project, in which the lowest and winning bid included a bid amount of \$400,000 for the sewer main relocation portion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, additional funding will be needed to meet the terms of the Utility Relocation Agreement, which requires a budget adjustment; and

WHEREAS, that adjustment is identified in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

- 1. Certain adjustments to the FY 2022-23 Budget are necessary as shown in Exhibit A.
- 2. There are sufficient funds to fund the allocations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Board of the Fort Bragg Municipal Improvement District No. 1 does hereby amend the previously adopted FY 2022-23 Budget to incorporate the changes enumerated in Exhibit A and does hereby authorize the City Manager to execute the Amendment.
