RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH KASL CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC FOR DESIGN AND ENGINEERING OF THE CHESTNUT STREET CORRIDOR PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$77,600; ATP GRANT-FUND NO. 413-5009-0319)

WHEREAS, the portion of Chestnut Street from Franklin Street to Ebbing Way lies within the City of Fort Bragg; and

WHEREAS, the City commissioned the "Chestnut Street Corridor Conceptual Plan and Right of Way Feasibility Study", November 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study determined a recommended project alternative improving and upgrading non-vehicular access along Chestnut Street; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg City Council selected Option A at its meeting of August 27, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg City Council reaffirmed its choice of Option A with minor revisions during its meeting of April 13, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Requests for Proposals based on Council direction were solicited on April 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2015 five proposals were received and opened in accordance with applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc. of Citrus Heights, California has been determined to be the most qualified firm; and

WHEREAS, staff has verified that KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc. is a civil engineering firm qualified to design the Chestnut Street Corridor Project; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$100,000 were appropriated in the FY 2015-2016 Capital Improvement Program Budget for this activity which are sufficient to cover this contract; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with KASL Consulting Engineers Inc. for design services to prepare contract documents for the Chestnut Street Corridor Project as presented in KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc.'s Consultant's Proposal which contains the scope of work, schedule, estimated work effort and cost, and rate schedule attached as Exhibit A to the Professional Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, a Professional Services Agreement is proposed to engage KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc. to perform the design services in an amount not exceed \$77,600; and

WHEREAS, said Professional Services Agreement with said Exhibit A is attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve a Professional Services Agreement with KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc. for design services for the Chestnut Street Corridor Project and authorizes the City Manager to execute same (Amount not to exceed \$77,600; Account No. 413-5009-0319).
