RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL DECLARING A STAGE 1 WATER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Fort Bragg continues to experience the effects of the on-going drought; and

WHEREAS, the City's raw water supplies are steadily declining; and

WHEREAS, the City is unable to maintain an adequate buffer between its ability to replenish water in its water storage facilities and the total daily water demand; and

WHEREAS, the City is mandated by the State of California to implement water conservation measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby declare a Stage 1 Water Emergency in accordance with the Fort Bragg Municipal Code; and the following additional measures are hereby established:

- a goal is set to reduce water usage by 20%
- the application of potable water to outdoor landscaping during and within 48 hours after measurable rainfall is prohibited, and
- operators of hotels, motels and other lodging establishments shall provide guests with the option of choosing to not have towels and linens laundered daily. Notice of this option shall be prominently displayed in each guest room using clear and easily understood language.

The above and foregoing Resolution was introduced by Councilmember _____, seconded by Councilmember _____, and passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg held on the 10th day of August, 2015, by the following vote:
