RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING BID OF GRANITE CONSTRUCTION, INC. AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE GREEN ALLEY PROJECT – PHASE II; CITY PROJECT NO. 2015-03 TO GRANITE CONSTRUCTION, INC. AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$212,488.00; ACCOUNT NO. 409-5011-0731)

WHEREAS, the Green Alley Project – Phase II (Project) to retrofit two alleys by adding various Low Impact Development (LID) features such as an infiltration trench and a vegetated swale and a bio-swale on the shoulder ; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Public Contract Code 20164 and other applicable laws, the Project was advertised for bid on July 23, 2015 and July 30, 2015 with bids due on August 6, 2015; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received with the apparent low bid coming from Granite Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$212,488.00; and

WHEREAS, staff is satisfied that Granite Construction, Inc. has the proper license, experience and meets the necessary requirements to complete the project as bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is funded by the Proposition 84 Storm Water Grant Program, Agreement #12-437-550; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

1. Granite Construction, Inc. bid meets the requirements of the Project bid documents and is considered responsive.
2. Sufficient funds are available through the appropriations made in the Green Alley Capital Project Fund to fully complete the project as advertised and bid.
3. Granite Construction, Inc. has the proper licenses to complete the Project and based upon previous experience in completing similar projects, is a responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby accept the bid of Granite Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive bid, awarding the contract for the Green Alley Project – Phase II; City Project 2015-03 to Granite Construction, Inc. and authorizes the City Manager to execute the same. (Amount not to exceed \$212,488.00; Account No. 409-5011-0731)
