

RESOLUTION NO. ____-2016

RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 7, 2016, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a Special Election consolidated with the Presidential Primary Election was held and conducted in the City of Fort Bragg, California, on Tuesday, June 7, 2016, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; election officers were appointed and, in all respects, the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Clerk-Recorder has canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council; and the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City was 2,133.
2. That the measure voted upon at the election is as follows:

MEASURE U:

Shall Chapter 18.22 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Bragg be amended to provide that a social service organization is a prohibited use within the Central Business District unless such organization was established and existed at a location within the district prior to January 1, 2015?	YES

3. That the number of votes given in the City for and against the measure was as listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
4. That the City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election more than 50% of the voters voting on the measure did vote against it, and the measure was defeated.

5. That the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the results of the election showing: (1) the whole number of votes cast in the City; (2) the measure voted upon; and (3) the total number of votes given for and against the measure.
