March 12, 2017

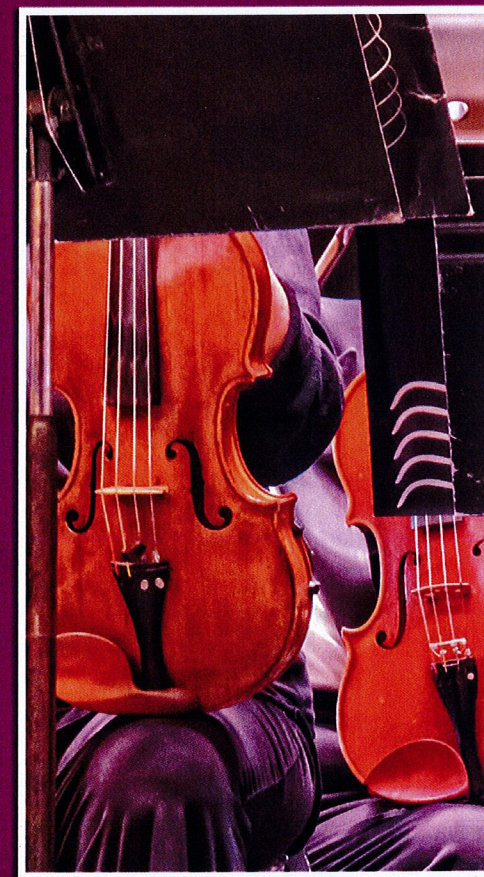

Presbyterian Church, in Mendocino.

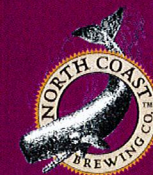
