RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING BUDGET AMENDMENT NO. 2017-18 AMENDING THE FY 2016/17 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNALLOCATED FUND BALANCE TO ACCOUNT NO. 110-4190-0319 TO COVER COSTS FOR AN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS "TABLETOP EXERCISE"

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Bragg, together with many partner agencies, shares responsibility for managing risks and responding to emergencies ranging from natural disasters like earthquakes and droughts, to human-caused disasters like hazardous materials spills and other accidents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Bragg is committed to increasing its disaster resilience; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to ensuring quality services in case of an emergency and

WHEREAS, ongoing "tabletop exercises" which provide comprehensive training to staff and partner agencies are an integral part of proper emergency management and response; and

WHEREAS, an all-day tabletop exercise, considered a high priority, has been scheduled with the City's management, mid-management, Police Sergeants, Public Works Leads, the Fort Bragg Fire Chief and other necessary staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve Budget Amendment No. 2017-18 amending the FY 2016/17 Budget to appropriate funds in the amount of \$2,000 from the General Fund unallocated fund balance to Account No. 110-4190-0319 to cover costs for contracting with qualified and experienced emergency management and response trainers to conduct the all-day tabletop exercise.
