- Any event shall not exclude public access in specified locations:
Glass Beach, Johnson Point, Otsuchi Point, and any trails.
- Alcohol beverage service may be allowed with an LTP or Council approved event. Complete a City Facility Alcohol Use Application. Permission from the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) as required.
