RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF ASSET FORFEITURE FUNDS FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATORS ASSOCIATION (LEAA) EDUCATION FUND TO MAKE A DONATION TO THE TIMBERWOLF BOOSTERS (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000; ACCOUNT #167-4216-0619)

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg Police Department has accumulated certain Asset Forfeiture funds as a result of participation in the Mendocino County Major Crimes Task Force; and

WHEREAS, LEAA Asset Forfeiture guidelines state that these funds shall be used for the sole purpose of funding programs designed to combat drug abuse and divert gang activity and shall, whenever possible, involve educators, parents, community-based organizations and local businesses, and uniformed law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg Police Department is committed to partnering with youthoriented community programs; and

WHEREAS, available LEAA Asset Forfeiture funds exist to provide for this donation; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

- 1. This donation will support the Timberwolf Boosters in funding youth sports and outreach programs.
- 2. This donation supports the City's commitment to its youth and the community as a whole.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby authorize the expenditure of LEAA Asset Forfeiture funds to be donated to the Timberwolf Boosters (Amount Not to Exceed \$20,000; Account #167-4216-0619).
