## RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG PLANNING COMMISSION TO THE CITY COUNICL RECOMENDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HISTORIC LANDMARK DISTRICT FOR DRY SHED 4

**WHEREAS,** The Coastal land Use and Development Code Section 17.74.030 provides a process whereby City Council can designate Historic Landmark Districts based on the evaluation of the age of the subject structure(s); distinguishing characteristics; distinct geographical area; familiar visual features; significant achievement; and/or distinctive features; and

**WHEREAS,** Dry Shed 4 on the Georgia-Pacific Mill Site is an approximately 70,000 square foot plywood shed with familiar visual features that are visible from many areas of Fort Bragg; and

**WHEREAS,** Dry Shed 4 has distinctive features such as a large gambrel roof, large massing and large doors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission considers these features of such importance to the City of Fort Bragg that Dry Shed 4 should be designated within a Historic Landmark District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission would like to nominate Dry Shed 4 as a Historic Landmark District; and

WHEREAS, the Project is exempt pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and Title 14, the California Code of Regulations ("CEQA Guidelines"), Section 15301 Existing Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, based on all the evidence presented, the Planning Commission finds as follows:

1. Dry Shed 4 offers familiar visual features and distinctive features and should thereby be designated as a Historic Landmark District by the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Planning Commission of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby recommend that City Council designate Dry Shed 4 as a Historic Landmark District and submit an LCP amendment to the Coastal Commission for certification of the designation.
