## 24 CFR 576.405 - Homeless participation.

## § 576.405 Homeless participation.

- (a) Unless the <u>recipient</u> is a <u>State</u>, the <u>recipient</u> must provide for the participation of not less than one <u>homeless</u> individual or formerly <u>homeless</u> individual on the board of directors or other equivalent policy-making entity of the <u>recipient</u>, to the extent that the entity considers and makes policies and decisions regarding any facilities, services, or other assistance that receive funding under Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG).
- **(b)** If the recipient is unable to meet requirement under paragraph (a), it must instead develop and implement a plan to consult with <u>homeless</u> or formerly <u>homeless</u> individuals in considering and making policies and decisions regarding any facilities, services, or other assistance that receive funding under Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). The plan must be included in the annual action plan required under 24 CFR 91.220.
- (c) To the maximum extent practicable, the <u>recipient</u> or <u>subrecipient</u> must involve <u>homeless</u> individuals and families in constructing, renovating, maintaining, and operating facilities assisted under ESG, in providing services assisted under ESG, and in providing services for occupants of facilities assisted under ESG. This involvement may include employment or volunteer services.
