## RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE 2017-2019 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE FORT BRAGG POLICE ASSOCIATION AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Fort Bragg Police Association (FBPA) commenced negotiations on May 10, 2017 for a new multi-year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

**WHEREAS**, during the process of negotiations, both parties presented proposals, which were discussed, countered, agreed to and/or withdrawn from the table; and

**WHEREAS,** the tentative agreements have been incorporated into the MOU, and the draft MOU has been through multiple reviews and revisions by both the City and the FBPA representatives; and

**WHEREAS**, the sessions concluded on October 11, 2017, when the parties agreed to a tentative agreement package, which was ratified by the FBPA membership; and

**WHEREAS**, the new MOU is complete and ready for signatures (see MOU attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference); and

WHEREAS, based on all of the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

- 1. The City and the Fort Bragg Police Association have undertaken to bargain in good faith and have negotiated a tentative agreement that has been reviewed by both parties and has been accepted and is now presented for adoption.
- 2. The 3% cost of living adjustments (COLAs) for FY 2017/18 reflected in the tentative agreement are appropriated in the FY 2017/18 budget.
- 3. Entering into the agreement provides for predictable labor costs for the term of the MOU and such costs are expected to be funded by ongoing revenues consistent with the City's Budget Guidelines.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve the 2017-2019 Memorandum of Understanding with the Fort Bragg Police Association and authorizes the City Manager to execute same.
