INTRODUCTION

The City of Fort Bragg charges fees to offset the cost of providing various services. Some fees are reviewed on an annual basis to assure that full cost-recovery is provided consistent with established City Council/Improvement District board policies.

The City and District have a policy of recovering the full costs reasonably incurred in providing miscellaneous services of a voluntary and limited nature, such that those receiving the miscellaneous services pay the associated costs and general taxes are not diverted general services of a broad nature to subsidize unfairly and inequitably such miscellaneous services. Pursuant to Government Code Section 66018, the specific fees to be charged for such services must be adopted by the City Council and the Municipal Improvement District Board after providing notice and holding a public hearing; The City Council and the Municipal Improvement conducted a public hearing on Nov 27th 2017, following proper notice, to obtain comments on proposed fee schedule.
