RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING AND EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE'S COMMUNITY FACILITY GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) administers a grant program that provides funding to develop essential community facilities, these are facilities that provide an essential service to the local community for the orderly development of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg City Council approved City of Fort Bragg Budget for FY 2018/19 on June 11, 2018 which included the replacement of one police vehicle as a top priority in FY 2018/19; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires that the Grantee match 45% of the project cost, of which \$25,850 has been identified in the Maintenance and Purchases budget for FY 2018/19; and

WHEREAS, this police vehicle is eligible under the USDA Community Facility Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

- 1. This funding will provide a usable tool for members of the Fort Bragg Police Department.
- 2. This funding will satisfy a top priority identified in the City of Fort Bragg's Budget for FY 2018/19 to replace one police vehicle in the fleet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve a United States Department of Agriculture's Community Facility Grant Program application to purchase one fully equipped police vehicle (match amount not to exceed \$25,850).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the USDA agreement and any amendments thereto in connection with the Community Facility Grant Program.
