CITY SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR APPOINTEE TO SERVE ON THE NOYO HARBOR COMMISSION

Applications are being accepted by the City of Fort Bragg from persons interested in serving as appointee to the Noyo Harbor District Board of Commissioners (Noyo Harbor Commission). This position is eligible for a four-year appointment which will run from October 31, 2018 to October 31, 2022.

The Fort Bragg City Council appoints two of the five members of the Commission; the County of Mendocino appoints two of the five members; and the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors and City Council jointly appoint the Chair. Terms on the Commission are for a four-year period.

To be eligible for appointment to the Noyo Harbor Commission, you must reside within the boundaries of the Noyo Harbor District. Persons interested in appointment are urged to contact City Clerk June Lemos at 961-1694 to obtain an application form.

Applications are due no later than Friday, October 12, 2018 by 5:00 p.m. Depending on the number of applications, the City Council may choose to interview applicants at a special meeting or at the regular City Council meeting on October 22, 2018.
