## RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 APPROVING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SHN CONSULTING ENGINEERS & GEOLOGISTS, INC. TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE SEWER LIFT STATION PROJECT, CITY PROJECT NO. 2019-01 AND AUTHORIZING DISTRICT MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME (AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$49,500; ACCOUNT NO. 716-7003-0731)

**WHEREAS,** the Municipal Improvement District No. 1 ("MID") Capital Improvement Program has identified upgrades to the Sewer Lift Stations (Project) as an important priority; and

**WHEREAS,** the District has secured funds from the Wastewater Enterprise to complete construction of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the District issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for construction management and inspection services; and

**WHEREAS,** two engineering firms responded to the RFP: SHN Engineers & Geologists, Inc. and LACO Associates, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the proposal review, staff has determined that SHN Consulting Engineers & Geologists, Inc. is best qualified to provide the desired services for the Project; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the District Board finds as follows:

- 1. The SHN Consulting Engineers & Geologists bid meets the requirements of the RFP and is considered responsive.
- 2. Sufficient funds are available through the funding source to cover the needed construction management tasks.
- 3. SHN Consulting Engineers & Geologists Inc. has the experience in completing similar projects, and is a responsible bidder.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the District Board of the Fort Bragg Municipal Improvement District No. 1 does hereby approve a Professional Services Agreement with SHN Consulting Engineers & Geologists, Inc. to provide construction management and inspection services for the Sewer Lift Station Project, City Project No. 2019-01 and authorizes the District Manager to execute same (amount not to exceed \$49,500.00; Account No 716-7003-0731).
