## RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE MENDOCINO COUNTY DIGITAL INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN 2019-2025 PREPARED BY THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & FINANCING CORPORATION

WHEREAS, according to the most recent California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) report, only 73% of households in Mendocino County had access to what the CPUC considers high-speed internet access; and

**WHEREAS,** a recent study by Purdue University found that for every dollar invested in "Broadband" infrastructure, \$4 of economic activity is created; and

**WHEREAS**, delivering high-speed internet in Mendocino County's rural and remote areas has many challenges and a strategic plan is critical for addressing those; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino County and Fort Bragg's goal is to develop the digital infrastructure needed to make available affordable high-speed internet to 98% of the households in the County by 2025; and

WHEREAS, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

- 1. Access by households in Mendocino County to affordable, safe and reliable high speed internet is important for the economic health of the City and the County.
- 2. There is a preference for high-speed internet to be delivered through underground fiber instead of wireless delivery.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Fort Bragg does hereby adopt the Mendocino County Digital Infrastructure Plan 2019-2025.
