I think it would be ideal if there were some exemptions outlined for typical "small" wisp-like installations. Define a minimum size for equipment and structures before they fall under some of the rules. Obviously, the code can't discriminate between similar service types, but small cell installations are often much larger than what wisps can often get away with.

For example, from the City of Ukiah planning code: "A ground- or building-mounted mast no more than twelve feet (12') in height and six inches (6") in diameter shall not be considered a telecommunications tower."
