Staff is seeking direction from the Finance and Administration Committee regarding priorities and goals for the Finance Department in the coming years. - Bruce Piercy commented on Measure H, new annexation, water sewer issues and TOT audit.

#### Discussion:

The Committee and Staff discussed in detail the goals recommended by Finance and Administration last year.

After lengthy discussion the Committee input on additional priority and goals are:

- 1. Expanding revenue with new events.
- 2. Long term annexations there are costs associated with this.
- 3. Use website to promote City and local attractions.
- 4. Other potential tax measures coming forward in November or later.
- 5. Bring back Increasing broadband coverage and ad hoc committee.
- 6. Possible advertising on city WIFI.
- 7. Tax Measures.
- 8. Increase TOT and Sales Tax by using Coastal trail, event committee for new and expanding events, hotel promotions.
- 9. Expanding MTA to bring people here.
- 10. Budget cuts by asking staff where these cuts can be made.
