U.S. – China Trade Talks end without a deal

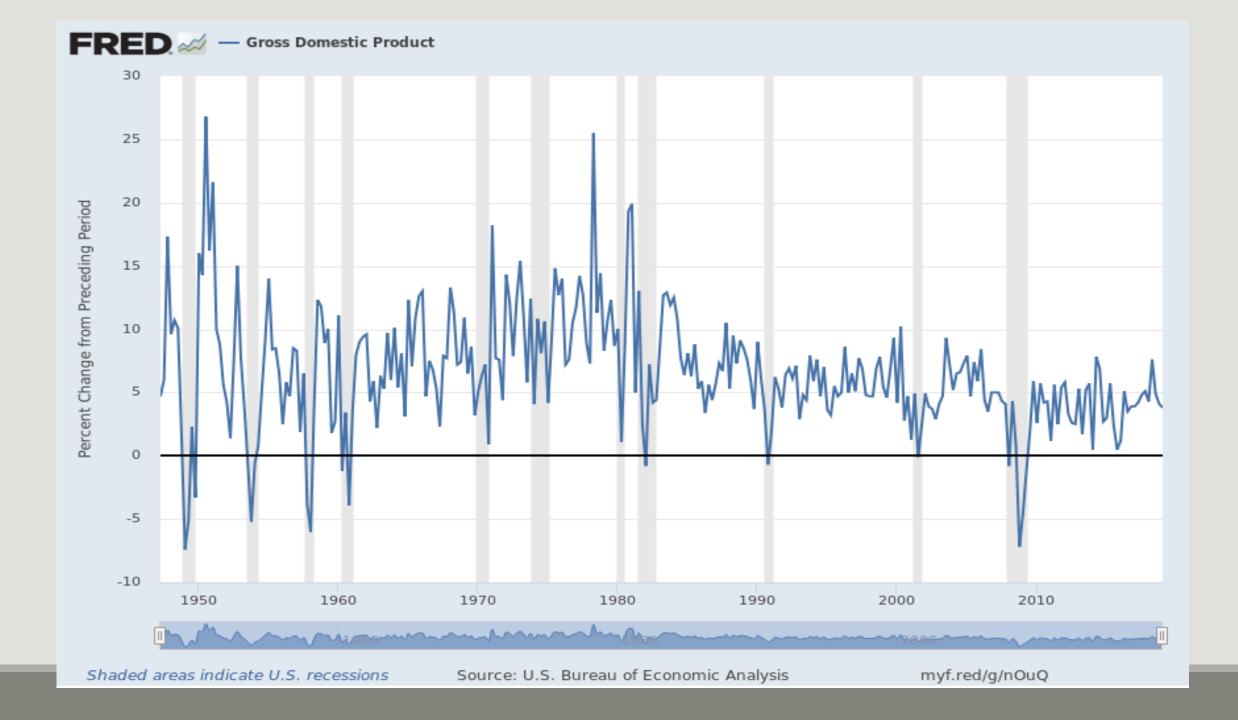
Unemployment – Record low 3.6%

- Unemployment expected to stay low for next year

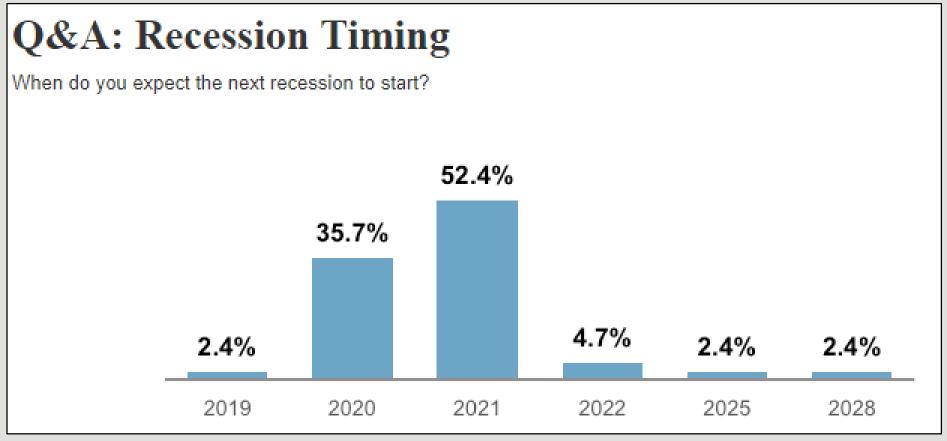
U.S. Personal Income ↑ 4.5%

#### Mendocino County – Fort Bragg

County Unemployment Rate 4.1% (CA.gov EDD)

CA County—Level 2018-2050 Economic Forecast reported that only 500 jobs had been created in Mendocino County since 2012 — average expansion of 1.9% - compared to statewide expansion of 2.6% per year.\*

Estimated Median Household income = \$50,453 (2017)

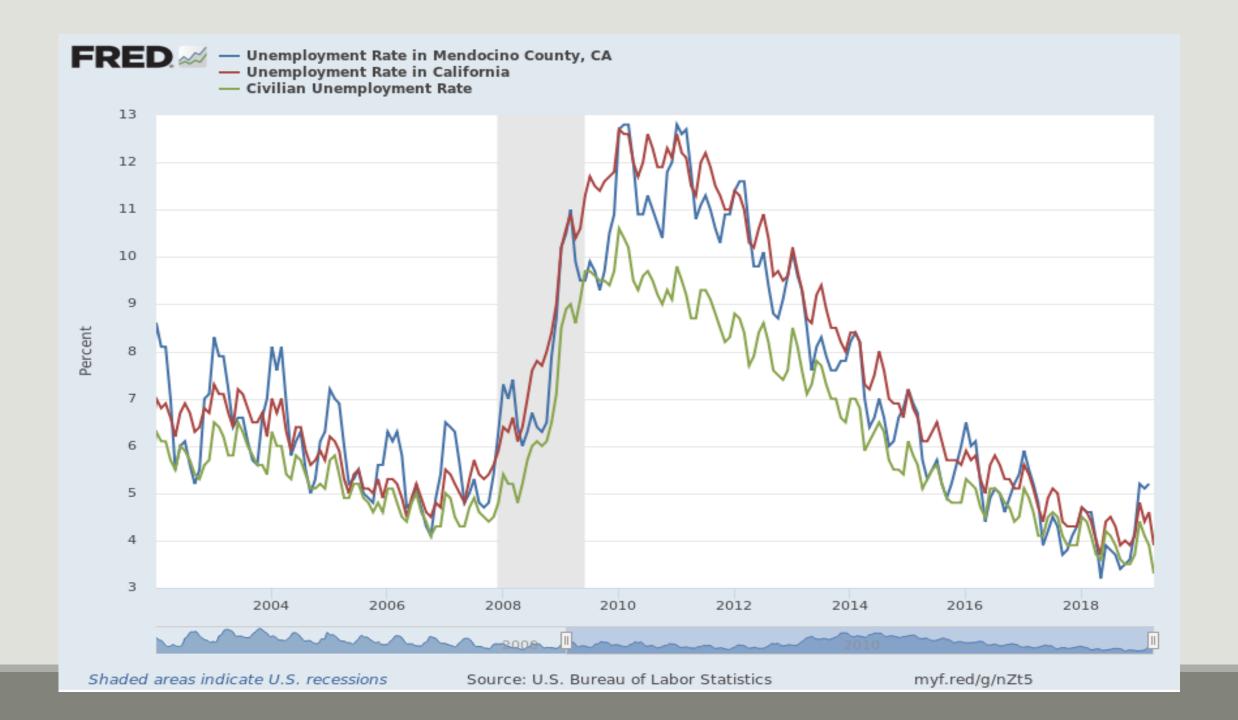

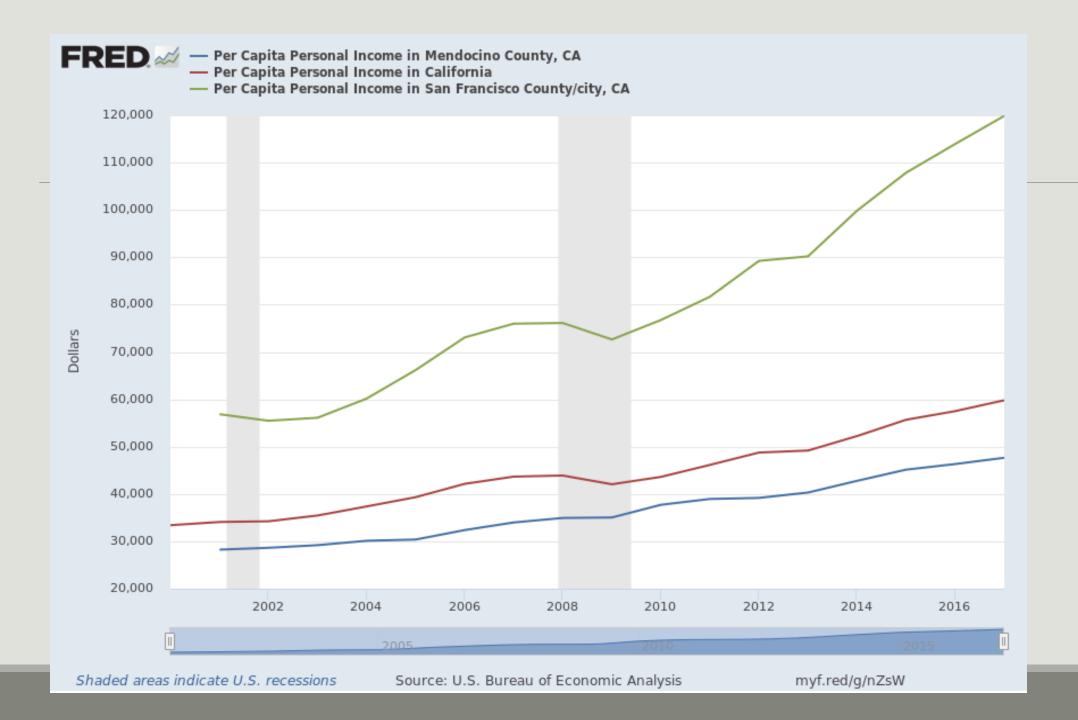

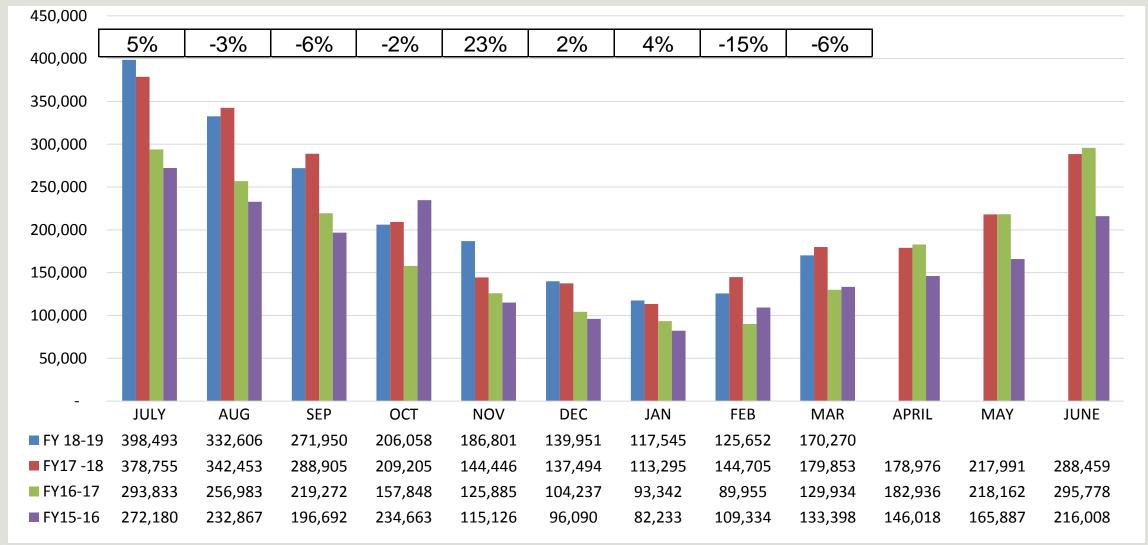
