**RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AN  
INCREASE IN THE HOURLY COMPENSATION FOR TEMPORARY  
PARKING ENFORCEMENT ATTENDANT**

**WHEREAS**, compensation for the seasonal temporary Parking Enforcement Attendant position has remained at \$15.00 per hour since 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the seasonal temporary Parking Enforcement Attendant position is limited to 1,000 hours per year and does not qualify for or receive the benefits package of a full-time Fort Bragg employee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Incumbent in the position has returned for a third season; and

**WHEREAS**, the Incumbent is fully trained, is experienced and has already been supplied with sufficient uniforms, thereby saving the City time and funds to train and outfit the employee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Incumbent provides a higher level of service due to her familiarity with the position and established relationships with the Police Department staff and local businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, based on all the evidence presented, the City Council finds as follows:

1. The proposed increase from \$15.00 per hour to \$16.00 per hour recognizes the added value and savings of rehiring the experienced Incumbent for the position of Parking Enforcement Attendant and encourages the Incumbent to return for additional seasons of employment with the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Fort Bragg does hereby approve the increase of \$1.00 per hour for the Temporary Seasonal Parking Enforcement Attendant.
