



Materials Accepted at Cold Creek Compost in the Green Cart

- Agricultural Materials, including from livestock operations
- Food Materials
 - All fruits and vegetables (including peelings, pits, and shells)
 - Bread, grains, pasta, and rice
 - Coffee grounds and tea leaves
 - Dairy products
 - Eggshells and eggs
 - Food leftovers and spoiled food (packaging removed)
 - Meat including bones
 - Seafood including shellfish
- Green Materials
 - All plant debris and landscape prunings including flowers, leaves, and weeds
 - Tree trimmings including branches, stumps, and trunks (make sure lid closes completely)
- Soiled Paper Products
 - Greasy pizza boxes and paper bags
 - Paper coffee filters and tea bags
 - Paper napkins and paper towels
 - Paper plates (non-coated)
 - Paper take-out boxes and containers (non-coated)
- Other Materials
 - Cooking grease: small amounts soaked up with a paper towel
 - Cotton balls and cotton swaps with paper stems
 - Hair (non-synthetic/non-colored)
 - Sheet rock
 - Wood ashes (cold)
 - Wood chips
 - Wood materials: small pieces of clean wood/sawdust (no plywood/painted/stained/treated wood)
 - Wooden chopsticks, coffee stirrers, and toothpicks

Materials **NOT** Accepted At Cold Creek Compost

- Aluminum foil or trays
- Biodegradable or compostable plastic
- Ceramic dishware or glassware
- Concrete or rocks
- Diapers
- Flower pots or trays
- Foil-backed or plastic-backed plastic
- Garbage
- Glass
- Household hazardous waste
- Insulation
- Medical waste including needles and sharps
- Metal
- Plastic products including bags, bottles, containers, and wrap
- Recyclables
- Styrofoam
- Wood – plywood, press board, painted, stained, or treated wood
