GFC will strengthen our community by encouraging home and community gardens and will:

- Improve the health and resilience of our community members
  - o Provide high quality organic produce
  - o Buffers community from risk of natural disasters and emergencies
  - o Increase nutrition and exercise while reducing diet-related disease
- Improve the health and resilience of our local economy
  - Localize food production o Create jobs
  - Enhance beauty and value of neighborhoods o Increase the prosperity of local businesses
- Improve the health and resilience of our ecology and environment
  - Promote healthy, carbon-sequestering soils
  - o Promote composting and water conservation
  - Creates habitats for rare species and pollinators
  - Decreases the need for importing foods
- Supplement our community's general happiness and communion
  - Encourage sharing of seed, food, and flowers
  - Develop a shared sense of investment in local resources and community
  - o Offer therapeutic and rehabilitation benefits
  - o Beautifies our community and brings back local food security

## In addition, GFC will:

- Celebrate: Host at least one educational event or garden opening each year to showcase gardening's role in conserving resources, promoting peace and creating resilience
- Publish Information: Install a GFC sign and webpage, increase accessibility to information on resource conservation, carbon farming and food production
- Promote Access: Encourage access to public and private lands for community gardens including:
  - Identifying and inventorying land that can be enhanced with community and home gardens
  - o Tracking annual area of gardens created or improved
  - Providing resources for the community to hold events and workshops to promote gardening
- Establish a Community Plan to Implement Gardens and Encourage Sustainable Practices
