Dear Mayor Lee and Fort Bragg City Councilmembers~

I plan to attend tonight's City Council meeting to speak on Agenda Item No. 8A but I think you might want to know the following before discussion:

While reading the summary a moment ago, I noticed that it doesn't include an image of the park as it is now. The illustration on page 1 is an image from the Master Plan before any improvements were made and I don't see an image of the park layout after Phase 1 improvements were implemented.

The Harrison Street entrance and the new park sidewalk are not located where shown on the illustration on page 1 of the summary; they are well to the south. The west entrance is near the spot where the numeral 2 is printed at the fence line on the layout, directly west of the basketball court. The new sidewalk goes straight east from the entrance and there's a jog in the sidewalk, near a new bench, continuing to the basketball court. The grassy area is broken up in a much different configuration from what you see in the illustration. If you aren't familiar with the park, your input about the southwest area amenities and activities, along with the new pavilion location, could be partially based upon a nonexistent layout. Please don't rely on the locations shown in the summary. Thank you.
