RESOLUTION OF THE FORT BRAGG MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AUTHORIZING DISTRICT MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT CHANGES FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE PROJECT, CITY PROJECT NO. 2018-01, INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH WAHLUND CONSTRUCTION, INC., BY A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$1,037,000

WHEREAS, the Fort Bragg Municipal Improvement District No.1 (District) has entered into a contract in the amount of \$15,352,500 with Wahlund Construction, Inc. (Wahlund) to complete construction of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Project (Project); and

**WHEREAS,** Wahlund provided a value engineering analysis to reduce the cost of the Project; and

**WHEREAS,** SHN provided a contract modification agreement, reducing their contract by \$173,713; and

**WHEREAS,** the savings throughout the Project was moved to the Project contingency; and

WHEREAS, the balance of the contingency is now \$1,037,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funds need to be spent before closeout of the Project or they must be returned to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA); and

**WHEREAS**, District staff has met with the USDA and discussed specific projects that would be eligible for use of these funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the improvements include the placement of new asphalt, purchase of two spare pumps, replacement of three Motor Control Centers, installation of a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition System and the addition of a septage receiving station; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Agriculture required the District to have HDR Engineering review and design the recommended projects; and

**WHEREAS**, staff is pleased with the subcontractors that will complete this change order work; and

**WHEREAS**, the USDA has authorized the District to use grant funds for this work; and **WHEREAS**, based on all the evidence presented, the District Board finds as follows:

- 1. The scope of work for each of these improvements meets the requirements of the regulatory and funding agencies.
- 2. Sufficient funds are available in contingency of the Wastewater Upgrade Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the District Board of the Fort Bragg Municipal Improvement District No. 1 does hereby approve the listed change orders to increase Wahlund's contract by a not to exceed amount of \$1,037,000 and authorizes the District Manager to sign same.
