


PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST (PRA) REPORT

In 1968, the California Legislature enacted the California Public Records Act (CPRA) under Government Code (GC) sections 6250-6270. In its findings and declarations, mindful of the right of individuals' privacy, the Legislature declared it was the public's right to access information concerning the people's business. The City of Fort Bragg understands and supports the public's right to access the public records created and maintained by the City in the course of regular business. It is the goal of the City to provide services in a transparent manner.


At the Committee's request, a summary of PRA requests received for January 1, 2019, to December 31, 2020, is listed below.
