CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Norvell called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

AGENDA REVIEW

Vice Mayor Godeke, appearing via Zoom, announced that he could not attend the meeting in person at Town Hall due to contracting a contagious disease. He requested Council approval to attend the meeting remotely for "just cause" pursuant to AB 2449. Mayor Norvell called for a voice vote to approve the Vice Mayor's attendance via Zoom, which was unanimously approved. - (4) Section II.9 Include the City's adopted "Rules of Civility" and attach them as an exhibit to the Administrative Regulation.
