### Adopt City Council Resolution Confirming the Continued Existence of a Local Emergency in the City of Fort Bragg

At a special meeting on March 24, 2020, the Fort Bragg City Council ratified the City Manager's Proclamation declaring a local emergency due to COVID-19 in its Resolution No. 4242-2020. On April 6, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 4245-2020 by which it continued the local emergency. On April 20, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 4247-2020 again confirming the continued local emergency. The local emergency was again reconfirmed on May 11, 2020 by City Council Resolution No. 4250-2020, on May 26, 2020 by City Council Resolution No. 4253-2020, and on June 8, 2020 by City Council Resolution No. 4266-2020. The City is required to reconfirm the existence of a local emergency every 21 days pursuant to Fort Bragg Municipal Code Section 2.24.040.
