Approve Letter of Commitment to Participate in the Mendocino Community Climate Collaborative for West Business Development Center's Grant Application for the Regional Climate Collaboratives Program

The Regional Climate Collaboratives Program (RCC) is a grant funding program administered by the California Strategic Growth Council (SGC). The RCC funds community-rooted and cross-sectoral partners to form a collaborative and conduct capacity building activities that will drive and sustain climate action. The Mendocino Community Climate Collaborative will be managed by West Business Development Center. The City of Fort Bragg will be a partner and co-applicant along with the following organizations: County of Mendocino, Mendocino County Climate Action & Advisory Committee, City of Ukiah, Coyote Valley Band of Pomo, Noyo Center for Marine Science, and the Grass Roots Institute. The requested funding will allow the City of Fort Bragg to conduct an energy audit and update the 2012 Climate Action Plan.
